PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Annual Plant Share — It's time to create your spring garden! Propagate plants from your yard and bring them with you to share with friends and neighbors. Master Gardeners will be on hand to answer questions.

Ask Your Master Gardener — Open Q & A session the first Tuesday of every month with Master Gardener, Tom Cuccia, at the Pearl River Library.

Autism Awareness — In recognition of Autism Awareness Month, join Amanda Martin Serpas, ABA, Outreach Coordinator for SOAR, as she discusses applied behavior analysis techniques for individuals and families living with Autism.

Beadworks: Nest Necklaces — Create your own unique wire and bead nest necklace. All supplies provided.

Beginner Yoga — Stretch, strengthen and relax with certified yoga instructor, Donna Bush, during this 6-week series of gentle yoga. Please bring your own mat and wear comfortable clothes.

Classical Guitar with Jeff Bianchi — Join us for a series of classical guitar performances around the parish by musician Jeff Bianchi.

Coloring Time — Coloring sheets from books designed especially for adults, crayons, markers and colored pencils will be provided or you can bring your own.

Geaux Native Garden Fest — Join the Louisiana Master Gardeners for this year's Garden Fest focusing on native plants and how to use them in your garden. Guest speakers, food tastings, local plant vendors selling native plants and flowers, and make-and-take activities for children and adults will make for a memorable day for the whole family.

Japanese Dance — Japanese Consulate recognized instructor, Sugai Barker, teaches this intro class to all skill levels.

Lagniappe Boating Day — Richard Clark with the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries will teach a Louisiana Boating Education Course. Completion of the course will result in the student being issued a vessel operators certification card. This event is part of the Louisiana Lagniappe series, and includes lunch.

Lawn Care & Maintenance — Presenter William Afton, the LSU AgCenter County Agent for St. Tammany Parish, will share the ins and outs of lawn care and maintenance as the spring and summer months approach. Mr. Afton holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Horticulture and Master of Science degree, also in Horticulture.

Marriage & Money — Bennett Blackledge will present how to openly talk about money, how to define shared financial goals, and respect each other's money skills at this one hour workshop aimed at those thinking about marriage as well as already married couples who need to get back on track financially.
