LIBRARY TO HOST COMMUNITY INPUT MEETINGS FOR FUTURE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

ST. TAMMANY – The St. Tammany Parish Library will be hosting community input meetings for the renovation of the Slidell branch and the replacement of the Lacombe branch.

Multiple library concepts will be presented to the Slidell and Lacombe communities. Attendees will be able to vote on the concepts they would like to see in their local library branch. These votes will help guide the upcoming Slidell branch renovation and the Lacombe replacement branch projects.

Two sessions for the Slidell branch renovation will be available at the Slidell branch (555 Robert Blvd., Slidell) on July 14. One session will be at 10:30 a.m. and another will be at 6:30 p.m. For those unable to attend, the community input boards will be available for two weeks, until 8 p.m. on July 28, at the Slidell branch.

The community meetings for the Lacombe replacement branch will be held on July 15 at the Lacombe Recreation District #4 (61100 N 12th St, Lacombe) gymnasium. The first session will be at 2 p.m. and the second will be at 7 p.m. The community input boards will be available at the Lacombe branch for those unable to attend both sessions for two weeks, until 6 p.m. on July 29.
